He has taught at the Architectural Association School of Architecture as a diploma unit master, at the IAAC as Faculty of digital fabrication, has been Associated Professor at the Ecole Spéciale d'Architecture in Paris and Studio director at the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne.

He has extensive experience in the format of international academic and professional workshops. Since 4 years, he runs the AA Visiting School Barcelona; has directed the workshop "Crade et Vivant" with Michel Gondry, an encounter between architecture and film at the IAAC; is hired by the University of Sinaloa (Mexico) for a yearly workshop on 1:1 construction of innovative structures; he has co-coordinated "House 1", an Epfl first year project of which the outcome is a 1:1 construction in Lausanne and co-directed "12 Cities", a 1:1 construction in Versailles...
