



The installation is in 2 parts:

- A. The smaller part is located adjacent to the escalator as per the Tayohya plan.
 B & C. The smaller parts are located partly in the Tayohya store and partly in the mall. The general design should allow the creation of a centrepiece visible from the escalator on the approach to the store. It could also be an area where the installation abuts shopfittings so that a raised area with a pic-nic style display can be part of the piece. This will be directly opposite the escalators approaching the store.

Final location to be agreed with the Xindiandi team and to meet local building regulations (widths of clear passageways shown on the drawing).

Landscape

The installation consists of 1 sq m or shaped elements which fit together like a jigsaw puzzle (see SHA 004 Construction Detail 3). These basic elements are 18mm MDF covered in high-density foam and moss-fabric, with pockets of florist's oasis for the 'planting' of artificial plants. There are some landscape elements which are made of foam & moss only and are positioned up in the branches of the trees to bring the landscape up to the viewer on the GF balcony (shown pale green).

Trees

There are 8 trees which consist of metal bases (see drawing SHA 003) and high-gloss painted timber trunks with branches. Most are free-standing and supported on their bases and by joining the branches of one tree to an adjacent tree. Some of these trees butt up to adjacent soffits (i.e. at the store entrance and those below the sloped soffit of the escalator).

Rocks

Suitable for sitting (400H), walking (18 -40mmH stepping stones) or the display of Tayohya goods (variable heights), these should be real stones OR resin covered/fibreglass but must be capable of bearing the weight of a standing person. They are painted in high-gloss resin to match the trees.
