

Hiding in Mountains and Seas, A Island Rouse of Western Xia Flavour.


We keep thinking what is Beidao Bay? What can we bring for this place? And what can it create for tourists?




In the very beginning, we went to the field trip with these thoughts. We watched documentaries, and browsed books and relevant data. Ningxia, located in the Silk Road, is one of the cradles of Chinese civilisation. Known as Southern Frontier, it gave birth to the ancient Yellow River civilisation. In 1038, Li Yuanhao, the chief of Tangut nationality, founded the Western Xia Dynasty here, creating immortal achievements and brilliant Western Xia culture. However, the Western Xia dynasty and its culture mysteriously disappeared overnight. With curiosity, we begin to sort out the venation of Western Xia culture. We deconstruct vegetation in the local natural landscape and brilliant cultural totems such as desert flowers, wolfberries, horses, and even the braids of Tangut people and the elegant clothes of the Princess of the Western Xia culture, and then recreate totem patterns with local culture. Adhering to the tradition and in line with contemporary aesthetics of life, keeping the design concept of simplicity and inheriting reconstruction, the Western Xia culture is interpreted as a rustic and luxury new aesthetics througzhout the whole space. These totems can be recreated into furniture, fabrics, art pendants, bathrobes, even keys and other decorations. It can be the symbol of N' insul. The differentiated design system of original art, original furniture and original brand peripheral framework enhances the competitiveness of commercial space. The spiritual totem of N' insul, I believe, is not only a kind of respect for Yellow River Hostel Set and N' insul itself, but also a kind of sincerity.
