


Casa IV




The house composition is based on a perfect geometry: a rectangular plan is surmounted by a simple gable roof, responding to precise measurements and transformations that respect pre-existing rules. The house is organized on two levels, one on the basement level and the other on the large loggia. The loggia is characterized by the rhythmic presence of metal profiles down to the lower level: it draws a large cross. The symmetry of the lateral elevation is unbalanced by the presence of the landscape that filters through one of the two openings.


Inside, the distribution foresees that all the main rooms have a privileged view to the south, while the service rooms are arranged along the north side. The elevations, marked by some regular openings, give the house a protective appearance. The austere house suddenly opens to the landscape and from the loggia, a real threshold between inside and outside, it is possible to see the Maremma up to the Giglio Island, as the last focal point of the horizon, where the land and the sea become indistinguishable.








Ground floor plan and first floor plan






Views of the main elevations
