

IRCCS San Raffaele Hospital - the new surgical center and ER for the hospital in Milan

The new surgical and emergency center of the San Raffaele Hospital is the heart of a consolidated and high density building fabric. The project, which is about to begin construction, has two complementary elements: the technical slab that houses the most important hospital functions, such as the surgical block with 20 operating rooms, intensive care, and first aid; and the tower, with the in-patient wards (300 beds) and outpatient clinics. The buildings are designed with a maximum rationality of layout and are characterized by careful management of the vertical and horizontal connecting spaces, as well as the harnessing of natural light to illuminate underground connections to the rest of the hospital.
