



Setting Out

The installation is to be set out measuring from the centre point of the base of the escalator. All floor fitted elements (fixed to the floor with double sided tape) are to be set out in the workshop prior to fitting on site and each element should be carefully annotated with its number and registration points to adjacent elements.

Trees: the circles represent tree-trunk positions. The ones shown filled in green are trees which connect to the soffit/ceiling above. They should take all their support from their metal base as they may not be able to be fixed to the ceilings.

The setting out point is the end of the escalators as shown. The final setting out locations for trees and rocks are TBA and will follow from the costings.

The installation is in 2 parts:

- A. The larger element is located beneath the escalator
- B. The smaller element is located partly in the Tayohya store and partly in the mall. The general design should allow the creation of a centrepiece visible from the escalator on the approach to the store. It could also be an area where the existing bed displaying lenses is positioned, with covering chosen to match the flowers, dark red to tone with the Tayohya signage and existing in-store displays.

Final location to be agreed with the Xindandi team and to meet local building regulations.
