HOUSE IN SANT FELIU DE BOADA, a craft refuge

The Espacio En Blanco studio transforms a country house in the heart of Ampurdán with care and enthusiasm

To decorate a house with such charm the interior designer Bárbara Aurell was inspired by the colors of the Ampurdán and in this way get the warmth and well-being that her clients were looking for. Spending time with the family and getting into their routine helped the designer to understand that this home needed spaces to receive visitors as well as to have dinner with friends. In addition to a rest area and an informal office. “The house is modern, but the Ampurdán asked for a little love for this house,” says Aurell.

That is why Barbara designed for clients a comfortable and perfect home to spend time with friends. Hence, lightness and mobility are the ideal characteristic of all the elements that make up the rooms. The living room includes a sofa and a daybed with Mallorcan handmade upholstery as well as design icons, such as the well-known DCW Plywood Chair, and made-to-measure elements. As the family is passionate about the world of art there is also space for special pieces, what is the wrought iron fireplace and the work that presides over it: a Bruno Ollé painting of large dimensions.

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A large continuous space shared by the living room, the dining room and the kitchen. Creating different environments for each moment always with the same essence.

Behind the living room is the dining area composed of a table with metal legs and an envelope of the same wood as the bench and the kitchen cupboards, unifying two spaces in one. In addition, the polished concrete floors and the neutral tones of the walls help to create harmony and give freshness to the room.

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It should be noted that the star rooms of the house are outside, so the lounge extends into a first porch where a sofa has been designed with the same wood as the facade, as if it were part of the same room. Can be enjoyed both in summer and on a sunny winter day.

In fact, with the second “chill-out” porch, located next to the pool, that same unification has been sought through a chromatic range, with brown, yellow and other tones, inspired by the local colors. It is also worth mentioning the use of the so-called Mallorcan “llengües” in different patterns that transmit that Mediterranean air so welcoming.

The naturalness, both of the “llengües” as of the linens, the espartos, the wood... as of the space, is the key characteristic that this house has so much personality and soul, creating a so particular atmosphere.



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The master bedroom, on the top floor, is made to measure and with love to make the most of any corner. The headboard of the bed is, in turn, a polished concrete closet that separates the bedroom from the bathroom. In addition, the informal work space requested by the owner has been resolved with a table structure that continues as a bank. Finally the room also has a private terrace, the ideal place to relax.
