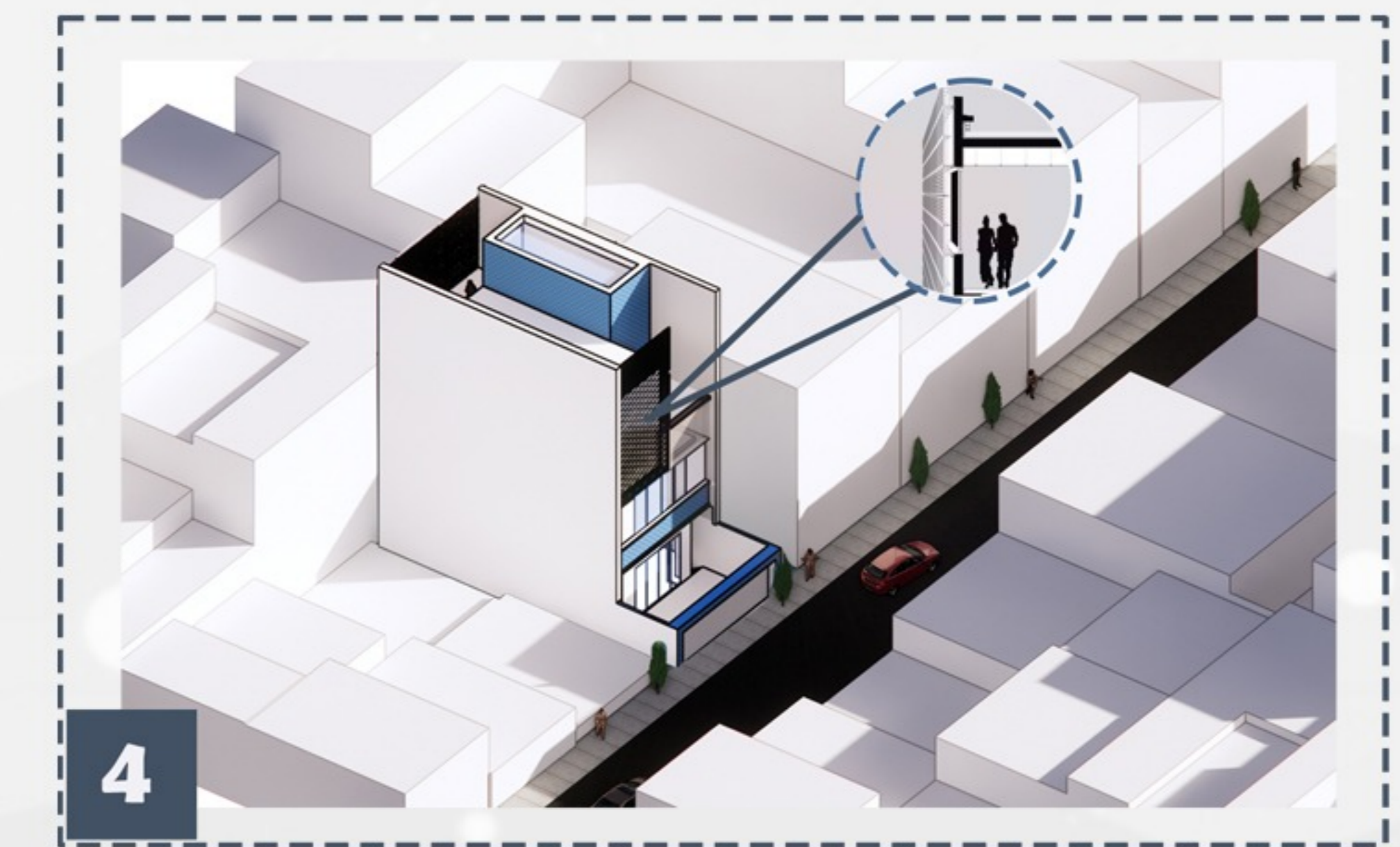
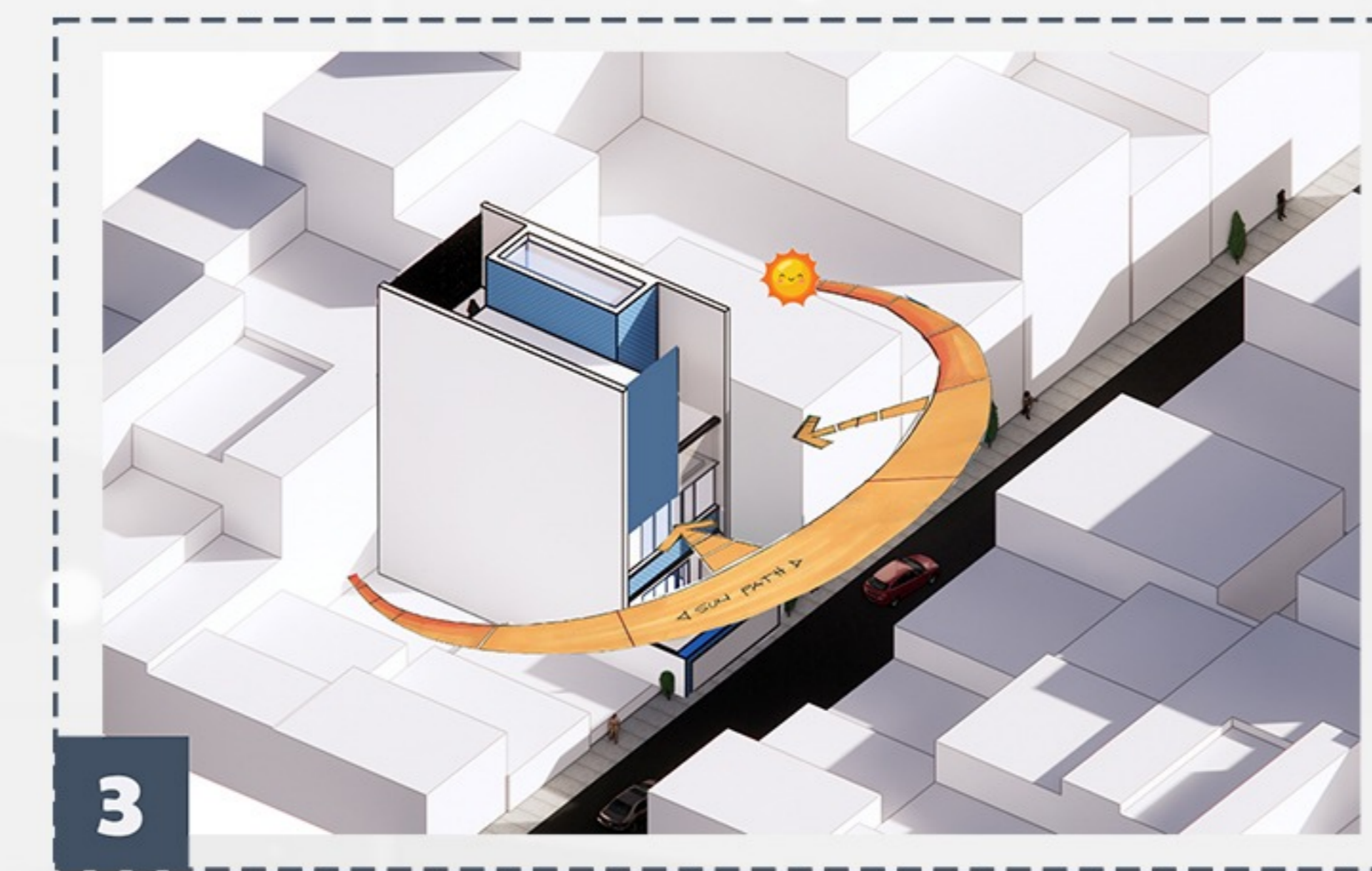
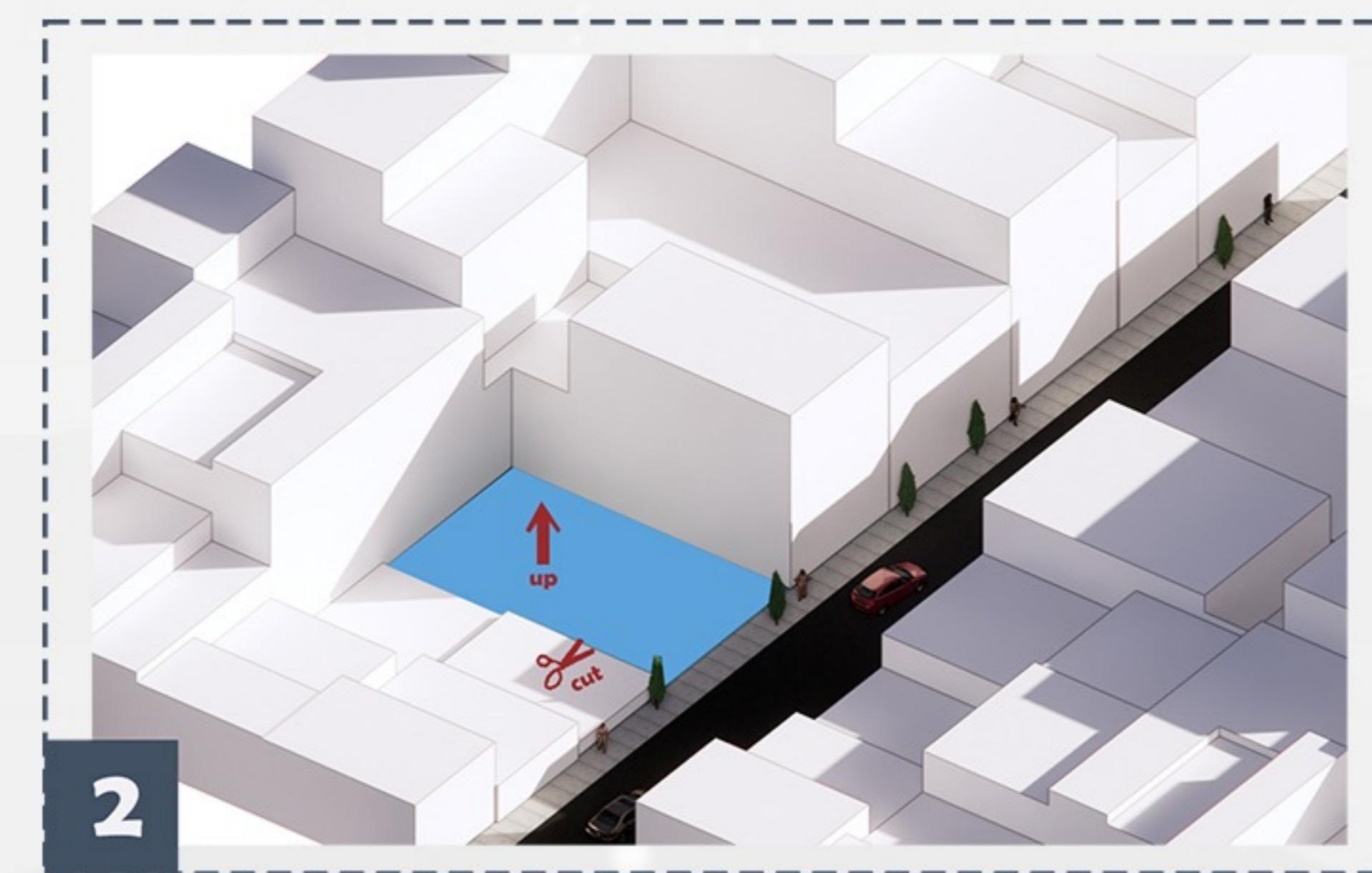
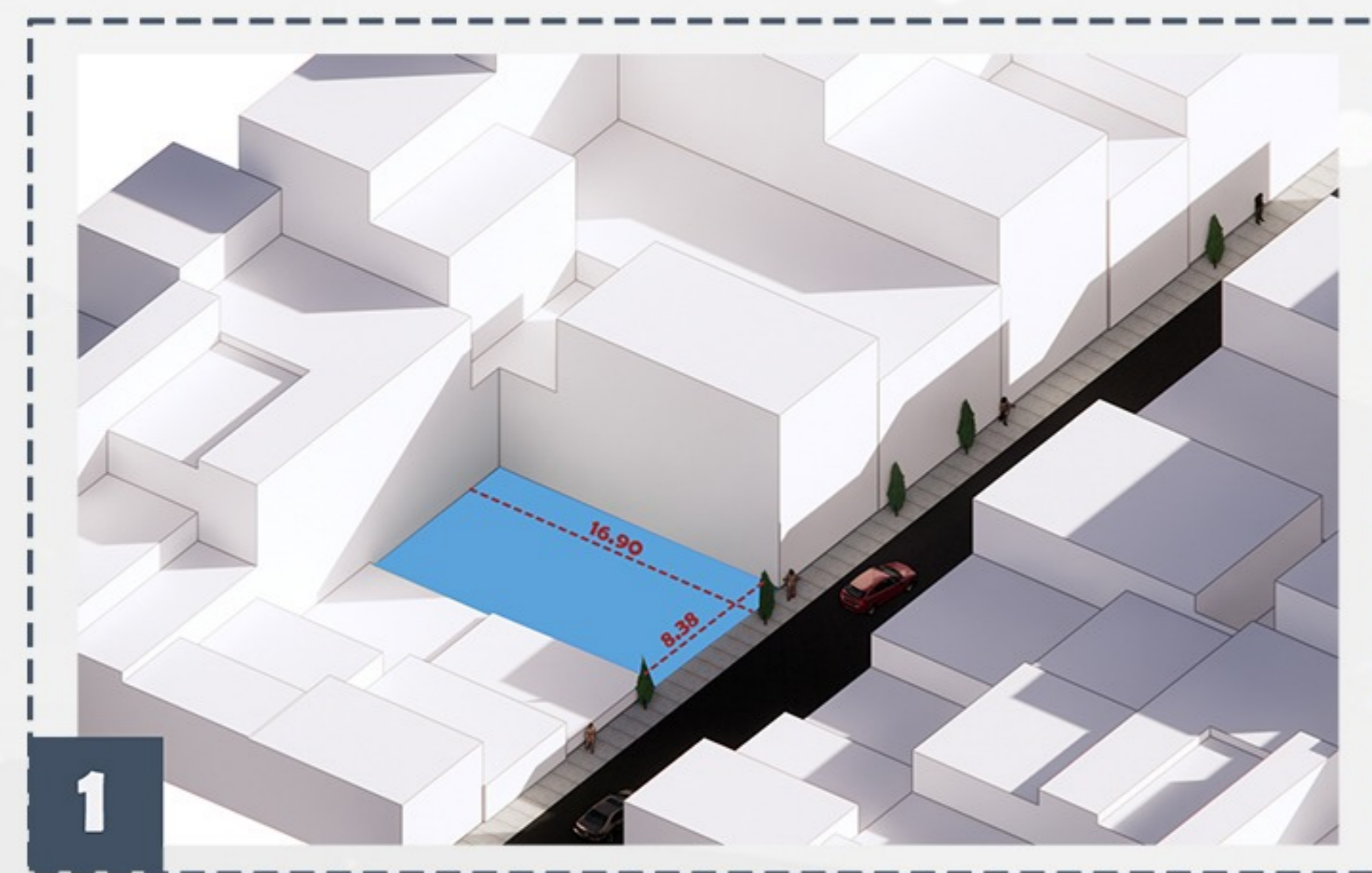
Sports and activities

Being active is as easy as possible and designers can encourage us. For example, an open, glass, and high-light staircase might encourage people to walk up to the third floor

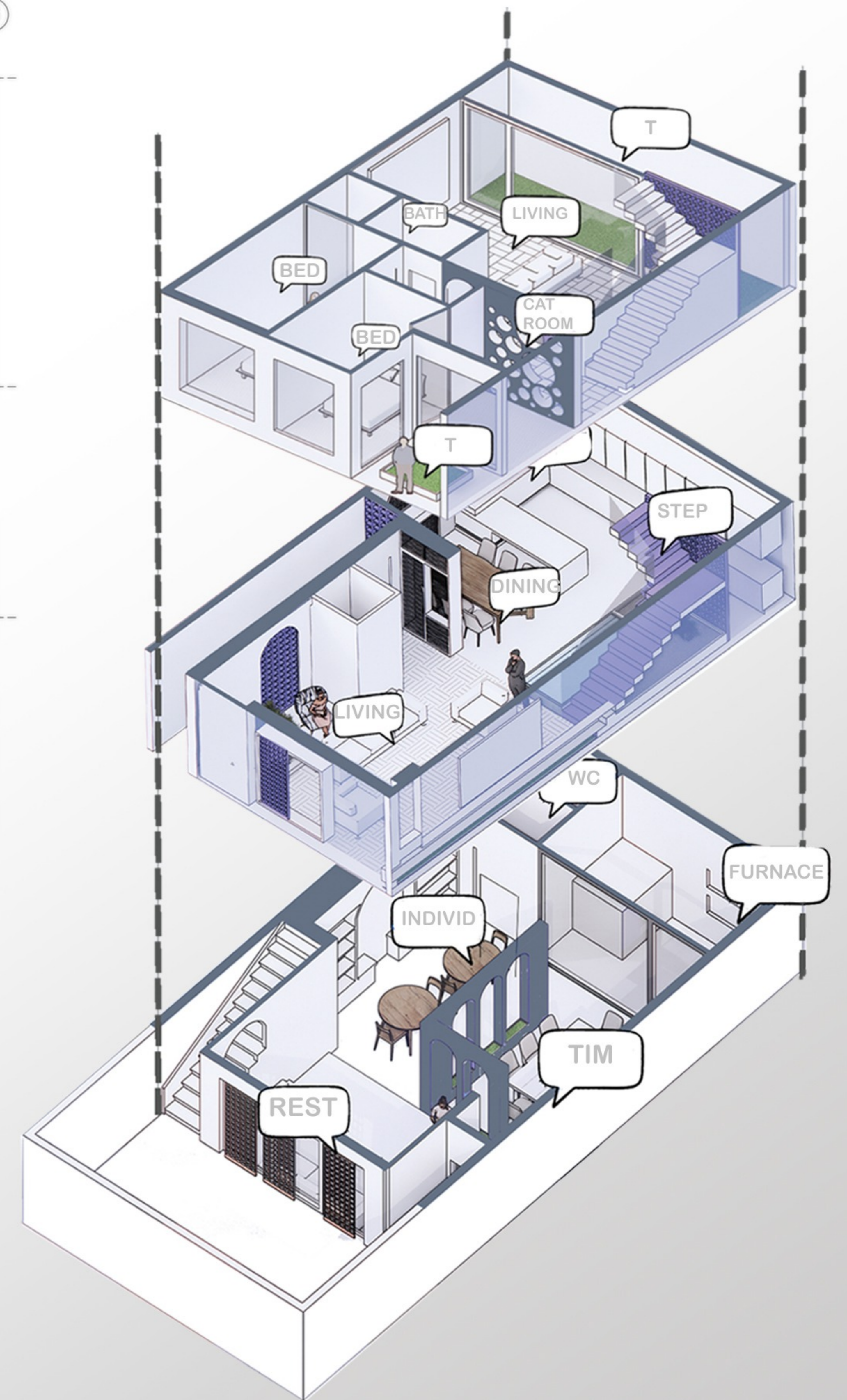
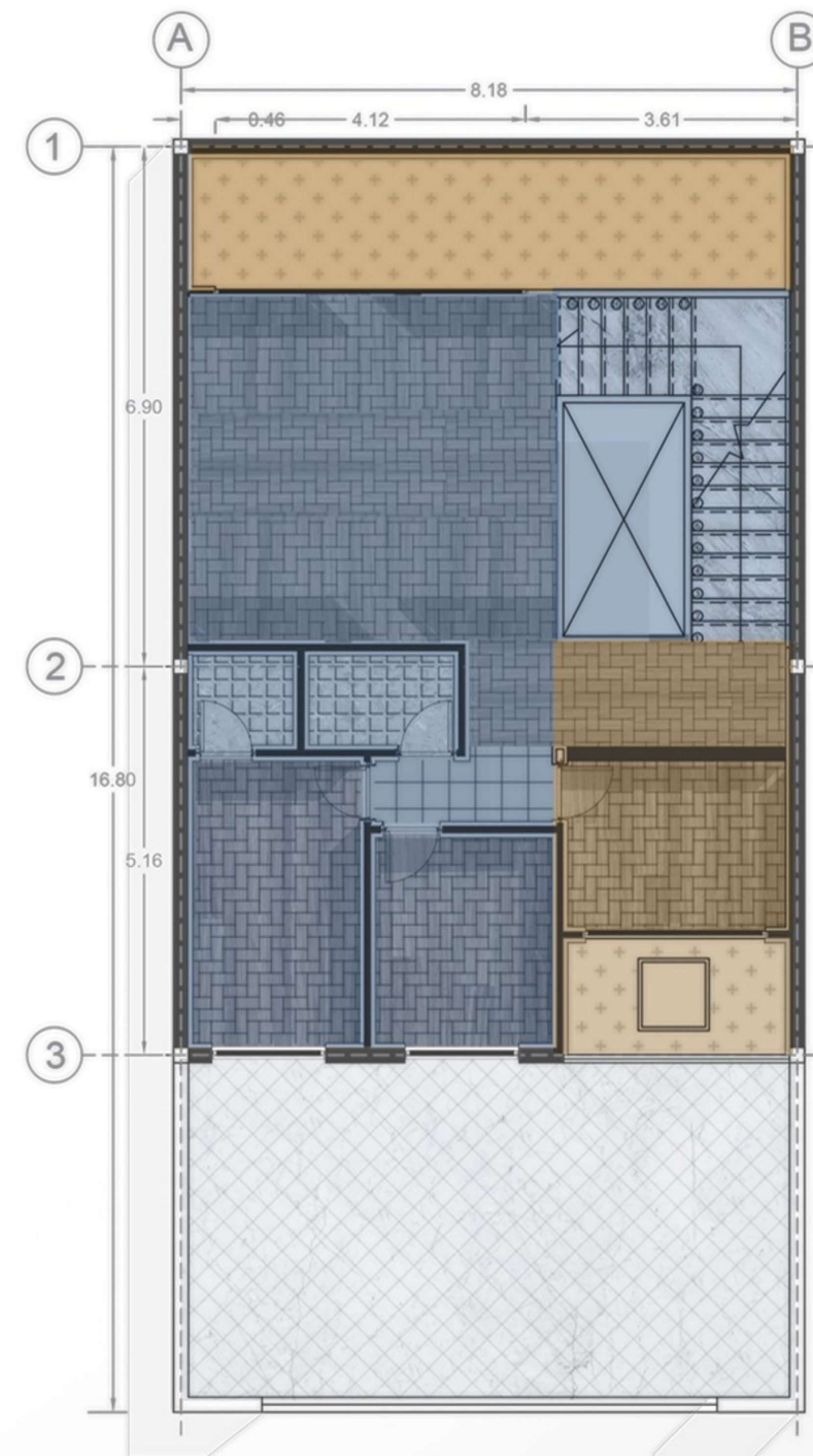
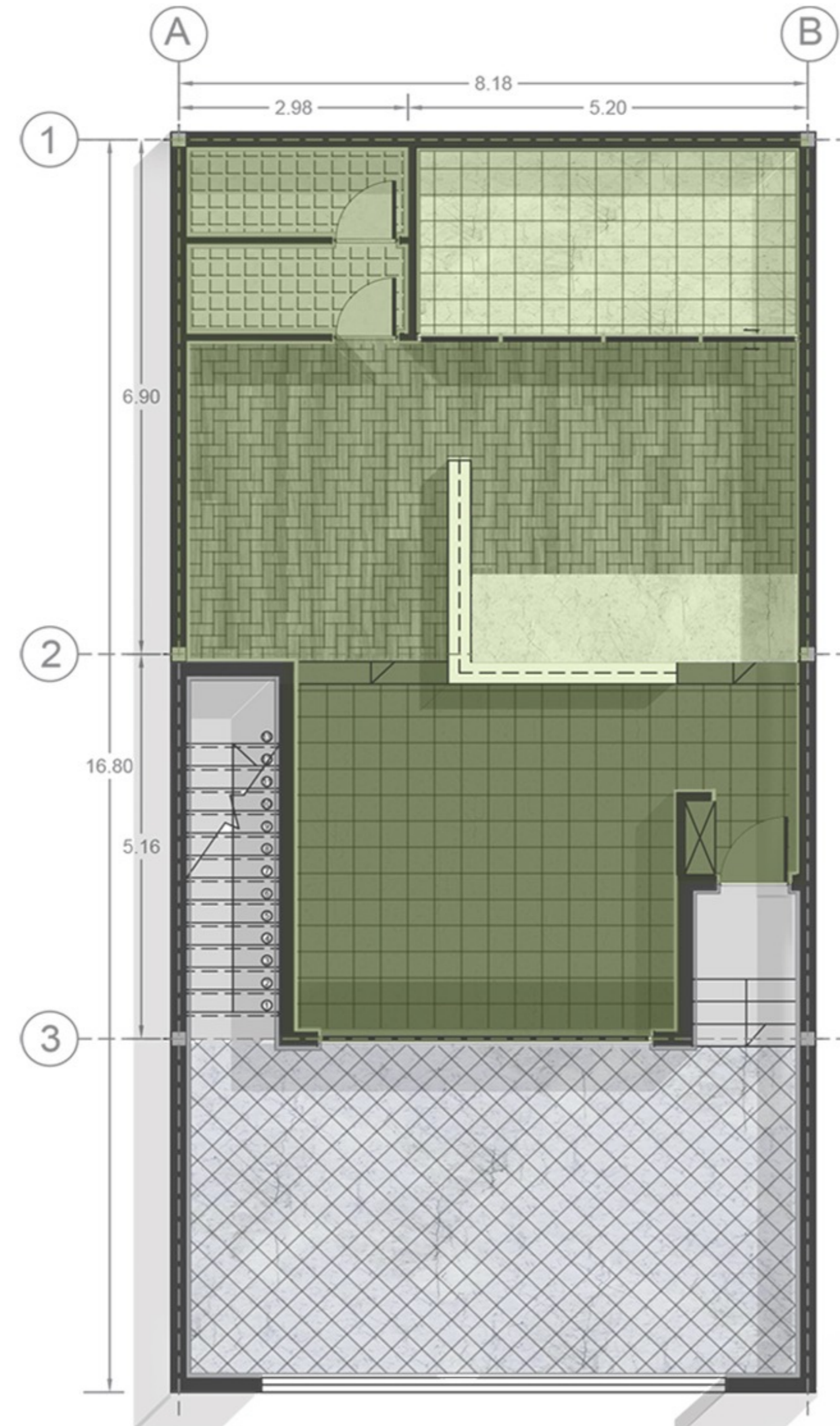
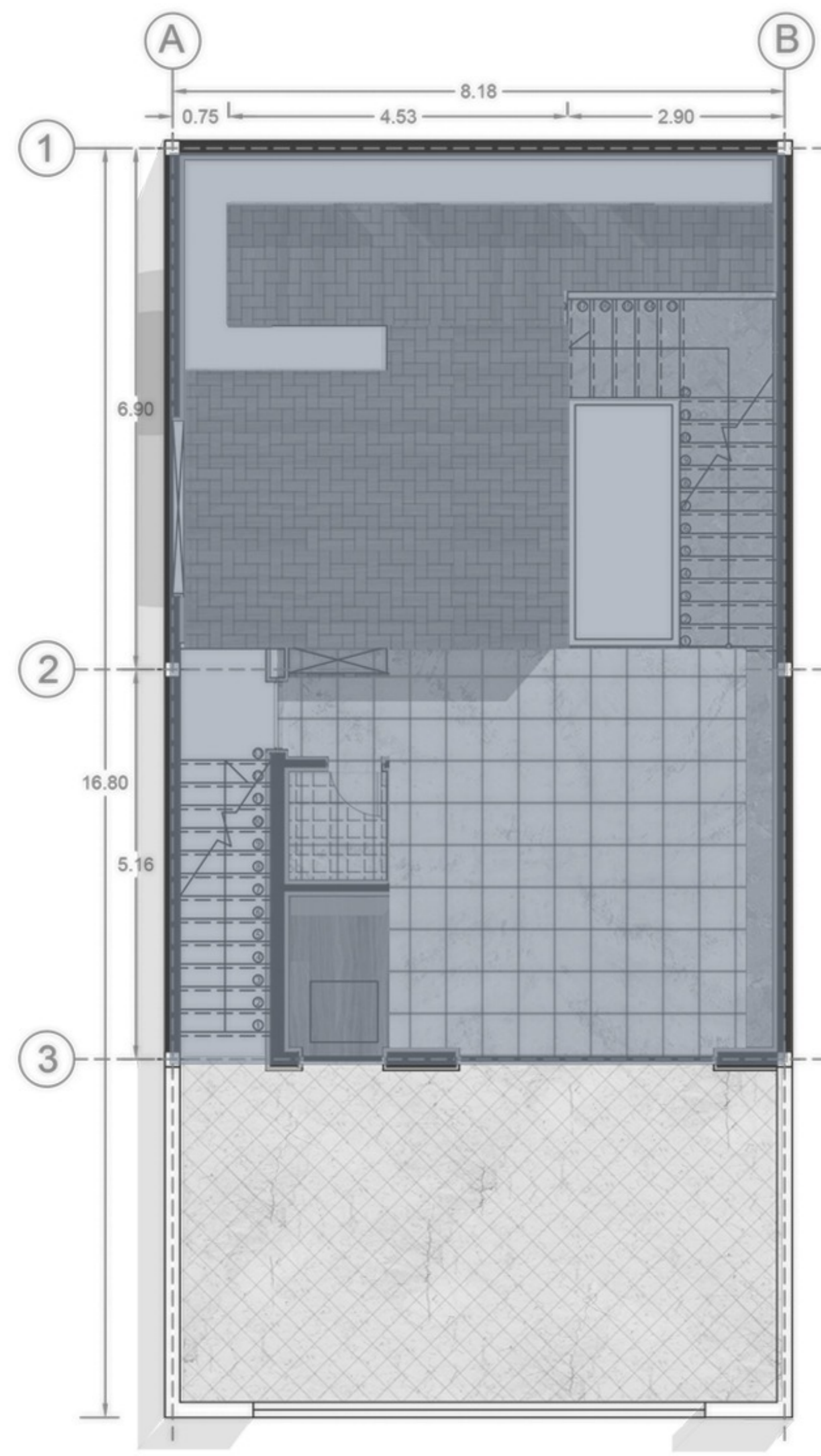
