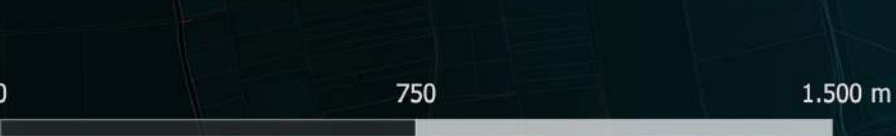

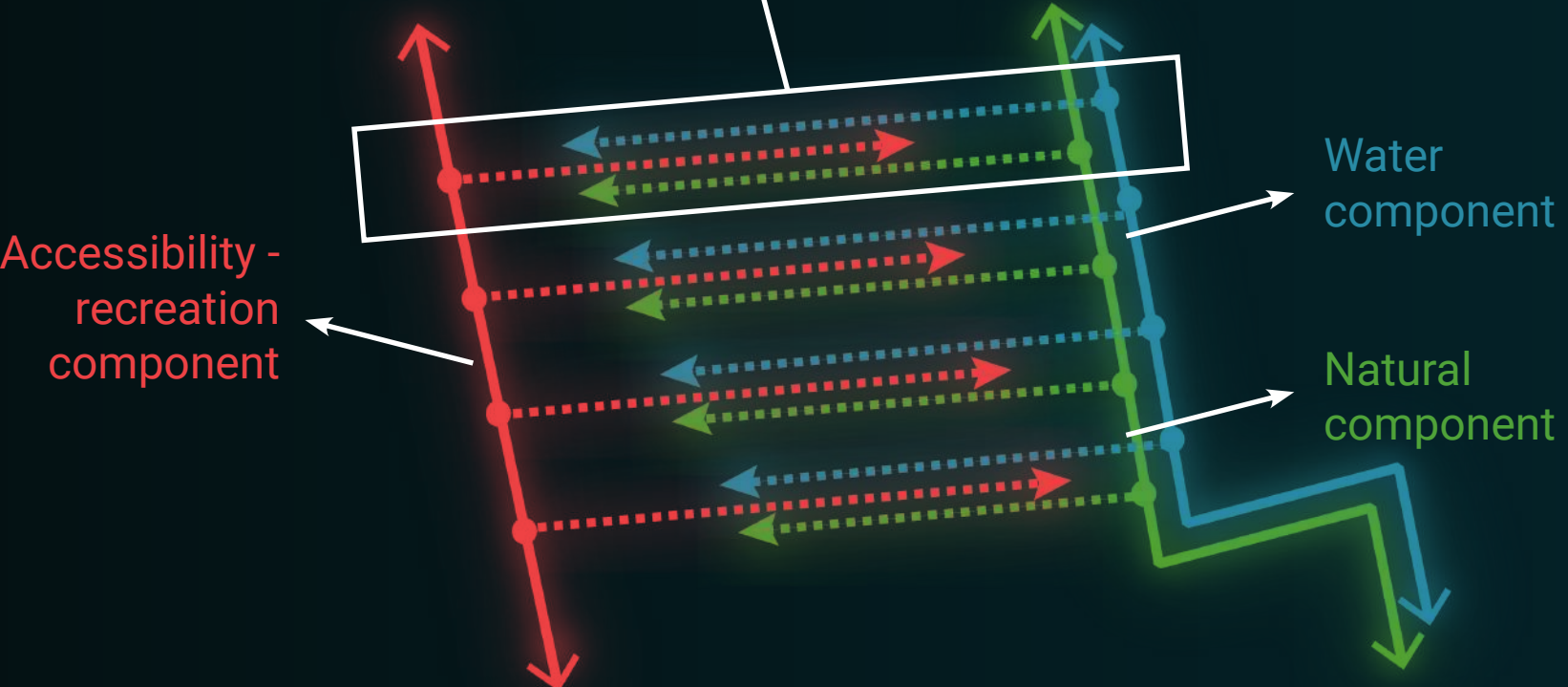
A TERRITORIAL STRATEGY

This new territorial system is a strategy for the development of the productive landscapes of the future. The fruition layer delineates a slow mobility itinerary from Milan to Pavia in which old and new cultural emergencies are connected; the natural and water layer extends the good practices of ecosystem restoration undertaken by the neo-rural pole by activating and improving ecosystem services; the space within them allows the permanence of agricultural and rice production and the integration of the new energy dimension. This territorial infrastructure will also allow the creation of a Renewable Energy Community (REC) to “feed” a series of adjacent functions, strengthening the relations between the urban and rural spheres. From a preliminary analysis of the project area some “anchor structure” of particular interest have been identified as potential members of the future REC. Several farmhouses, religious settlements, public buildings and, farms and commercial activities, located in the territory of the surrounding municipalities can benefit from the Community’s self-production of renewable energy.
