



CONSTRUCTION

The installation is largely constructed off site in panels consisting of a MDF base, foam & oasis. The moss fabric will be fitted on site so that the edges can be carefully cut so that the covering appears to be seamless. It will be pinned into position using upholstery pins and sealed using dabs of hot glue (glue gun). The foam will be no higher than 300mm of FFL at any point but will need to be at least 150 mm high where there are plants so the oasis is concealed. Note - the rigid foam may be walked on but the oasis is fragile.

The trees will go into place first. They are conceived as groups so that the linking branches allow each group to be self supporting. The panels will be cut to fit around the trees prior to fitting on site. It is important that all the NON-PLANT components are fitted together off site and clearly labelled before they are brought to Xintiandi.

- Moss fabric fixed with upholstery pins and hot glue.
- Susan's Garden artificial flowers and grasses
- Florist's 'Oasis' or other point for fixing plants & flowers
- Rigid Foam
- Moss fabric fixed with upholstery pins and hot glue.
- 18mm MDF fixed to the ex. floor covering with double sided tape
