THE "NEXUM" DIRECTIONAL PARK in the words of the architect

"In imagining the NEXUM Management Park, we started from the idea of developing 4.0 offices according to three simple concepts:

1. Work like at home:

I am surrounded by greenery, I have outdoor spaces such as balconies and loggias where I not only find moments of regeneration, but also spaces for alternative and informal meetings, and relaxation areas to disconnect and give ourselves a break. As though I were in a small, friendly village, I find meeting and leisure spots such as the playroom, the cafeteria or the small auditorium, making me feel like I'm in a new, technological, flexible environment that has a "domestic" and welcoming dimension.

2. Nurture creativity:

NEXUM is a creative workshop where the differentiation of spaces and functions allows me to work in a dynamic environment, a hub of discovery and experimentation, suitable for different types of tenants.

3. Benefit from an eco-sustainable, efficient and wellbeing-focused building: The project strives to include the most innovative protocols and standards in its strategies relating to the comfort and environmental quality of the building.
