



PARADISO IBIZA ART HOTEL Passionate about Contemporary Art

PARADISO IBIZA ART HOTEL, the latest project by the Concept Hotel Group, is set to open in Ibiza on 7 June later this year. Devoted to art and contemporary creation and borrowing inspiration from the aesthetics of MiMo—Miami Modern—the new hotel introduces a whole new way of visiting the island, surrounded by high quality art.

ART PARADISO, a new holiday experience

The hotel will host an ongoing ART PARADISO curated programme.

Directed by the artist and curator Iñaki Domingo and the photographer and filmmaker Diana Kunst, the programme will present a range of projects focusing on urban art and performance, an art gallery housed in the hotel itself and a programme of micro-residencies for artists.

Guests will be completely surrounded by art in a unique setting, with works by contemporary artists installed in all the hotel's Art Rooms. The hotel also has its own Art Library specialising in contemporary art where guests can browse at any time and discover the latest happening trends in art.

Art Rooms

The hotel's art programme includes collaborative projects with several contemporary artists who will exhibit their works in the hotel rooms, making each one a totally unique space for guests.

The artists already working on the project include Marcos Torres, Pau Sanz i Vila and Thani Mara, as well as Yoko Honda and Marylou Faure. This mix of international artists was chosen by the curatorial team after meticulous research and assessing the quality of the works. Paradiso Ibiza Art Hotel aspires to become a benchmark for the local art scene.

Zero Suite Residencies

To further bolster the promotion of young, avant-garde artists, Art Paradiso is also organising Zero Suite Residencies, a programme of short-duration residencies aimed at bringing a series of leading international artists to the island.

The programme will take place one weekend per month in Zero Suite, the hotel's most special room. Located in the lobby, it consists of a transparent cube where artists who don't mind being seen from all angles will be offered free stays.

The guest artists invited on the micro-residencies will inhabit the glass-walled Zero Suite, where they will create their interventions while soaking up the experience of Paradiso Ibiza Art Hotel and the atmosphere that permeates the island.

Likewise, all the artists taking part in the Art Paradiso programme's various projects will also be invited to carry out Take Overs of the hotel's social media. Take Overs is conceived to be a dynamic project exploring digital art and interaction.

A small number of Arty Parties will also be held throughout the season. These exclusive soirees will mix art, music and fashion in the uniquely Ibiza style.

Art Gallery

One of the strong points of the programme is Art Gallery. During the high season this gallery, located in the hotel, will hold three exhibitions related with the concept of the hotel. Each show will also feature tie-in activities involving the exhibiting artists.

The gallery will be accessible both from inside the hotel and from the exterior, thus opening it up not only to the hotel's guests, but to the general public with the aim to integrating it fully into the island's art scene.

Ibiza through art

The new hotel's mission is to transform and expand the island's tourist offer, programming exhibitions and activities showcasing the latest happening trends in art.

The Art Paradiso programme is open to the hotel's guests, but also to all inhabitants and visitors to Ibiza. Art Paradiso will be a new hub for Ibiza's cultural scene, ensuring that it gains in quality, diversity and contemporaneity with this unique tourist concept.

Concept Hotel Group is an Ibiza-based hotel chain. Over the last six years it has introduced its new concept in accommodation into the island, based on impeccable design by the architecture and interiors studio [ilmiodesign](#). Paradiso Ibiza Art Hotel now joins Santos, Tropicana, Dorado and Cubanito as the group's fifth concept hotel. Though five very different experiences, they all share the common denominator of uniqueness and innovation, where guests always come first.
